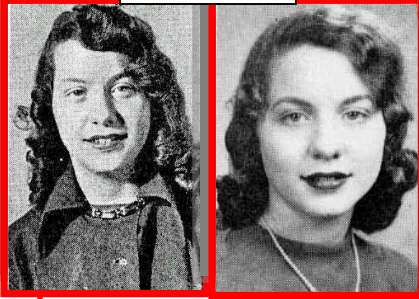


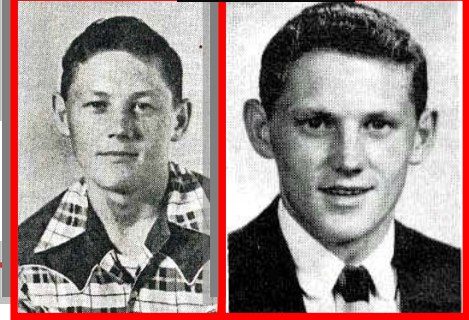

She coordinated drives for Food, Fans, Eye Glasses, and Hearing Aids for the needy, collected items for the abused Mothers & Children, and a Towel drive for the Tulsa Boy's Home.

She created a SWB Pioneer Cookbook as one of her fundraisers. Sales exceeded \$50,000. Proceeds were donated to McCaul's Chapel, a School for the challenged.

Aline has been called on many times to use her creative and artistic abilities to help certain organizations that were on limited budgets to save money on their decorations.

Aline first married in 1958 and had one son. Ten years later she divorced and married former classmate, Charles Wisner and had a second son.
